

## COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2555/76

of 21 October 1976

amending Regulation (EEC) No 1948/76 with respect to the quantity and time limit fixed for the delivery of skimmed-milk powder to the Italian intervention agency

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 563/76 of 15 March 1976 on the compulsory purchase of skimmed-milk powder held by intervention agencies for use in feedingstuffs<sup>(1)</sup>, and in particular Article 9 thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1948/76 of 5 August 1976 on the supply of a first lot of skimmed-milk powder to the Italian intervention agency for use in accordance with Regulation (EEC) No 563/76 and amending Regulation (EEC) No 789/76<sup>(2)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2481/76<sup>(3)</sup>, provides that the German, French and Luxembourg intervention agencies are to deliver to the Italian intervention agency 7 500 metric tons of skimmed-milk powder between 16 August and 20 October 1976; whereas, first, the time limit fixed for delivery was too short and must again be extended; whereas, secondly, an additional quantity of 450 metric tons may be made available to the Italian intervention agency by the German intervention agency;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

Regulation (EEC) No 1948/76 is amended as follows:

1. In Article 1 the expression '7 500 metric tons' is replaced by '7 950 metric tons'.
2. In Article 2 (1), the phrase 'between 16 August and 20 October 1976' is replaced by 'between 16 August and 10 November 1976'.
3. In the Annex, as regards BALM, the figure '3 400' in the 'Total' column is replaced by '3 850', and the figures '1 000' and '700' in the 'Partial quantities column' are replaced by '1 150' and '1 000' respectively.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
