

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 983/76

of 27 April 1976

fixing the minimum prices for exports to third countries of corms, bulbs and tubers of begonias, dahlias, gladioli and sinningias

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 234/68 of 27 February 1968 on the establishment of a common organization of the market in live trees and other plants, bulbs, roots and the like, cut flowers and ornamental foliage⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 7 (1) thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1767/68 of 6 November 1968 on the system of minimum prices for exports to third countries of flowering corms, bulbs and tubers⁽²⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 468/74⁽³⁾, provides that the minimum export prices for the species in question must be fixed each year and are applicable to products harvested in the year following that in which they were fixed; whereas, for the export year 1 June 1976 to 31 May 1977, these prices should be varied according to country of destination, marketing conditions and size;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Live Trees and Other Plants, Bulbs, Roots and the like, Cut Flowers and Ornamental Foliage,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The minimum prices for the export year 1 June 1976 to 31 May 1977 are hereby fixed, for each product, as shown in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
