

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2198/77  
of 4 October 1977**

**fixing the import levies on white sugar and raw sugar**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN  
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European  
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No  
3330/74 of 19 December 1974 on the common organ-  
ization of the market in sugar<sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by  
Regulation (EEC) No 1110/77<sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular  
Article 15 (7) thereof,

Whereas the import levies on white sugar and raw  
sugar were fixed by Regulation (EEC) No 1436/77<sup>(3)</sup>,  
as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2187/77<sup>(4)</sup>;

Whereas it follows from applying the rules and other  
provisions contained in Regulation (EEC) No 1436/77  
to the information at present available to the Commis-

sion that the levies at present in force should be  
altered as shown in the Annex to this Regulation,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

*Article 1*

The levies referred to in Article 15 (1) of Regulation  
(EEC) No 3330/74 are, in respect of white sugar and  
standard quality raw sugar, hereby fixed as shown in  
the Annex to this Regulation.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 5 October  
1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member  
States.
