

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2774/77

of 14 December 1977

on the delivery of various consignments of skimmed-milk powder as food aid

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2560/77⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7 (5) thereof,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1766/77 of 25 July 1977 laying down general rules for the supply of skimmed-milk powder as food aid to certain developing countries and international organizations under the 1977 programme⁽³⁾, and in particular Article 6 thereof,

Whereas, under the food-aid programme adopted by the Council Regulation specified in the Annex, the League of the Red Cross Societies has requested the delivery of the quantities of skimmed-milk powder as set out therein ;

Whereas, therefore, delivery should be effected in accordance with the rules laid down in Commission

Regulation (EEC) No 303/77 of 14 February 1977 laying down general rules for the supply of skimmed-milk powder and butteroil as food aid⁽⁴⁾; whereas, in particular, the periods and terms for delivery and the procedure to be followed by the intervention agencies to establish the costs arising therefrom should be laid down ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

In accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EEC) No 303/77, the Dutch intervention agency shall deliver skimmed-milk powder as food aid on the special terms set out in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

- (2) When the unloading at the port of disembarkation Bombay is carried out under the supervision of an agency approved by the recipient country, the intervention agency may accept, in the place of the supporting documents referred to in Article 21(a) of Regulation (EEC) No 303/77, an official statement from such supervising agency certifying that the quantities concerned have been delivered to the port of unloading Bombay (deposited on the quay or on lighters) and unloaded in that port.
- (3) Only in the case of delivery 'to the port of unloading' and 'free at destination' ; see Article 5 and the last indent of Article 13 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 303/77.
