

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 2185/78
of 19 September 1978

extending the period of validity of Regulation (EEC) No 2862/77 on levies applicable to imports of certain adult bovine animals and beef from Yugoslavia

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament⁽¹⁾,

Whereas the system applicable to imports of certain bovine animals and beef from Yugoslavia was laid down in Regulation (EEC) No 2862/77⁽²⁾; whereas this system applied until 31 August 1978;

Whereas the reasons which obtained on the introduction of these arrangements continue to apply; whereas pursuant to Article IX of the Trade Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia⁽³⁾ will be extended by tacit consent; whereas the said system should therefore continue to apply,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In the second paragraph of Article 2 of Regulation (EEC) No 2862/77 '31 August 1978' shall read '31 December 1978'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

It shall apply with effect from 1 September 1978.

However, the levy fixed pursuant to this Regulation for the period from 1 September 1978 until the date of entry into force of this Regulation shall only apply at the request of an interested party.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
