

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2586/78**  
**of 30 October 1978**  
**re-establishing intervention buying-in of beef in France**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal<sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 425/77<sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 6 (4) (b) thereof,

Whereas in application of Article 3 (1) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 995/78 of 12 May 1978 fixing the guide price and the intervention price for adult bovine animals for the 1978/79 marketing year<sup>(3)</sup>, intervention buying-in was suspended by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1244/78 of 9 June 1978 temporarily suspending intervention buying-in of certain qualities of meat in certain Member States<sup>(4)</sup>;

Whereas the market prices for 'Bœufs O' recorded in France on 19 and 26 October 1978 had returned to a

level below the maximum buying-in price fixed for this quality; whereas intervention buying-in for this quality must recommence, in accordance with Article 3 (3) of Regulation (EEC) No 995/78,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

Buying-in by the French intervention agency shall recommence on 6 November 1978 for the following quality:

'Bœuf O'.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 6 November 1978.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
