

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1043/79
of 28 May 1979

completing Regulation (EEC) No 2036/74 fixing prices for the sale at reduced prices to certain institutions and bodies of a social character of hindquarters of adult bovine animals held by the intervention agencies

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 425/77 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7 (3) thereof,

Whereas the selling prices for beef and veal held by the intervention agencies were fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2036/74 ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 803/79 ⁽⁴⁾;

Whereas it appears appropriate, as a matter of priority, to provide for the sale of the oldest meat;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 295/79 ⁽⁵⁾ limits such sales to meat bought in before 31 December 1978;

Whereas it is now appropriate to release further beef for this sale;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 2036/74 is completed by the following:

Article 1a

The intervention agencies shall give priority to sales of meat which have been in store longest.

They may in no case sell meat which they have received after 31 March 1979.'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
