

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 519/79

of 19 March 1979

amending Regulations (EEC) No 1634/77 and (EEC) No 1790/77 on standing invitations to tender in order to determine export refunds for sugar

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 3330/74 of 19 December 1974 on the common organization of the market in sugar⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1396/78⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 19 (4) thereof,

Whereas partial invitations to tender are issued for exports of white sugar and raw beet sugar by virtue of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1634/77 of 19 July 1977 on a standing invitation to tender in order to determine export refunds for white sugar⁽³⁾, and by virtue of Regulation (EEC) No 1790/77 of 2 August 1977 on a standing invitation to tender in order to determine export refunds for raw beet sugar⁽⁴⁾, both as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 279/79⁽⁵⁾; whereas for administrative purposes the opportunity

should be taken to modify the date of a partial invitation to tender;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Sugar,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Articles 3 (3) (b) of Regulations (EEC) No 1634/77 and (EEC) No 1790/77, 'Tuesday 8 May' shall be replaced by 'Thursday 10 May'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
