

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 614/79
of 30 March 1979
fixing the export refunds on isoglucose

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1111/77 of 17 May 1977 laying down common provisions for isoglucose ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1298/78 ⁽²⁾, and in particular the first sentence of the third subparagraph of Article 4 (2) and paragraph 5 thereof,

Having regard to the opinion of the Monetary Committee,

Whereas, pursuant to Article 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 1111/77, provision may be made for an export refund for isoglucose;

Whereas the level of the refund must be determined, per 100 kilograms of dry matter, taking into account the following, in particular:

- the export refund on products falling within subheading 17.02 B II a) of the Common Customs Tariff;
- any production refund granted for the basic product used in the manufacture of products falling within subheading 17.02 B II a);
- the production levy referred to in Article 9 of Regulation (EEC) No 1111/77 and the economic aspects of the proposed exports;

Whereas, following the judgment rendered by the Court of Justice of the European Communities in Cases 103/77, 125/77 and 145/77, there is uncertainty as to whether the abovementioned production levy is to be taken into account in the calculation of the refund; whereas it is therefore appropriate not to take the said levy into account in the calculation at present but to provide for the refund to be increased by an amount equal to that of the production levy, should there be one, in force at the time of export of the quantity of isoglucose in question;

Whereas the refund must be the same throughout the Community; whereas it may be varied according to destination;

Whereas the said refunds must be fixed every month; whereas they may be altered in the intervening period;

Whereas the refund is granted only in respect of isoglucose satisfying the conditions laid down in Article 3 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1469/77 of 30 June 1977 laying down rules for applying the levy and the refund in respect of isoglucose and amending Regulation (EEC) No 192/75 ⁽³⁾;

Whereas, if the refund system is to operate normally, refunds should be calculated on the following basis:

- in the case of currencies which are maintained in relation to each other at any given moment within a band of 2.25 %, a rate of exchange based on their effective parity;
- for other currencies, an exchange rate based on the arithmetic mean of the spot market rates of each of these currencies recorded for a given period in relation to the Community currencies referred to in the previous indent;

Whereas it follows from applying the detailed rules set out above that the refund for isoglucose should be as set out in the Annex hereto;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Isoglucose,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The export refunds on the products referred to in Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 1111/77 shall be as set out in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

The amounts indicated in the Annex shall, at the request of the interested party concerned, be increased by an amount equal to the production levy, should there be one, in force on the day of the completion of the customs export formalities in respect of the products shown in the Annex.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 April 1979.
