

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2397/81
of 20 August 1981
amending Regulation (EEC) No 1885/80 laying down detailed rules imple-
menting the system of premiums for maintaining suckler cows

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No
1357/80 of 5 June 1980 introducing a system of
premiums for maintaining suckler cows⁽¹⁾, as
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1417/81⁽²⁾, and in
particular Article 6 thereof,

Whereas, in practice, the time limit fixed by Article
3 (1) of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1885/80⁽³⁾
has proved inadequate; whereas the said Regulation
should therefore be amended;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation
are in accordance with the opinion of the Manage-
ment Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Article 3 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1885/80 is
hereby replaced by the following :

'1. The amount fixed in Article 3 (1) of Regula-
tion (EEC) No 1357/80 shall be paid within 14
months following the beginning of the period
referred to in Article 1 (1).'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its
publication in the *Official Journal of the European
Communities*.

It shall apply with effect from 12 August 1981.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
