

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2535/82
of 17 September 1982**

**fixing for the fourth quarter of 1982 the quantities of high-quality fresh, chilled
or frozen beef and veal which may be imported under special conditions**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 217/81
of 20 January 1981 opening a Community tariff quota
for high-quality fresh, chilled or frozen beef and veal
falling within subheadings 02.01 A II a) and 02.01 A II
b) of the Common Customs Tariff⁽¹⁾, as amended by
Regulation (EEC) No 3715/81⁽²⁾, and in particular
Article 2 thereof,

Whereas Article 7 of Commission Regulation (EEC)
No 263/81⁽³⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No
3751/81⁽⁴⁾, provides that the quantities of meat
referred to in Article 1 (1) (d) thereof which may be

imported under the tariff quota shall be fixed for each
quarter ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation
are in accordance with the opinion of the Management
Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The quantity of beef and veal referred to in Article 1
(1) (d) of Regulation (EEC) No 263/81 which may be
imported for the fourth quarter of 1982 is hereby fixed
at 6 093 tonnes.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its
publication in the *Official Journal of the European
Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
