

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2729/82**  
**of 12 October 1982**  
**amending Regulation (EEC) No 2669/82 introducing a countervailing charge on**  
**cucumbers originating in Spain**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN  
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European  
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No  
1035/72 of 18 May 1972 on the common organization  
of the market in fruit and vegetables<sup>(1)</sup>, as last  
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1738/82<sup>(2)</sup>, and in  
particular the second subparagraph of Article 27 (2)  
thereof,

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 2669/82<sup>(3)</sup> introduced a  
countervailing charge on cucumbers originating in  
Spain;

Whereas Article 26 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No  
1035/72 laid down the conditions under which a  
charge introduced in application of Article 25 of that

Regulation is amended; whereas, if these conditions  
are taken into consideration, the countervailing charge  
on the import of cucumbers originating in Spain must  
be altered,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

The amount '10.64 ECU' appearing in Article 1 of  
Regulation (EEC) No 2669/82 is replaced by the  
amount '31.03 ECU'.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 13 October  
1982.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member  
States.
