

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2779/82
of 18 October 1982
amending for the second time Regulation (EEC) No 2669/82 introducing a
countervailing charge on cucumbers originating in Spain

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No
1035/72 of 18 May 1972 on the common organization
of the market in fruit and vegetables⁽¹⁾, as last
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1738/82⁽²⁾, and in
particular the second subparagraph of Article 27 (2)
thereof,

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 2669/82⁽³⁾, as amended
by Regulation (EEC) No 2729/82⁽⁴⁾, introduced a
countervailing charge on cucumbers originating in
Spain;

Whereas Article 26 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No
1035/72 laid down the conditions under which a
charge introduced in application of Article 25 of that

Regulation is amended; whereas, if these conditions
are taken into consideration, the countervailing charge
on the import of cucumbers originating in Spain must
be altered,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The amount '31.03 ECU' appearing in Article 1 of
Regulation (EEC) No 2669/82 is replaced by the
amount '35.18 ECU'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 19 October
1982.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
