

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 3703/84**of 28 December 1984****fixing the amount of the aid for peas, field beans and sweet lupins used in the feeding of animals**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1431/82 of 18 May 1982 laying down special measures for peas and field beans ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1032/84 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 3 (6) thereof,

Whereas the amount of the aid referred to in Article 3 of Regulation (EEC) No 1431/82 was fixed by Regulation (EEC) No 2749/84 ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3363/84 ⁽⁴⁾;

Whereas it follows from applying the rules and other provisions contained in Regulation (EEC) No 2749/84 and in Article 105 of the Act of Accession of Greece to the information at present available to the Commission that the amount of the subsidy at present in force should be altered as shown in Article 1 of this Regulation,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The amount of the aid referred to in Article 3 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1431/82 is fixed at:

- 12,968 ECU per 100 kilograms for peas and field beans processed in Member States other than Greece,
- 12,766 ECU per 100 kilograms for peas and field beans processed in Greece,
- 15,239 ECU per 100 kilograms for sweet lupins.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1985.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
