

**COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 440/85**  
**of 18 February 1985**

**on the conclusion of the Agreement in the form of an exchange of letters  
between the European Economic Community and the Kingdom of Morocco  
concerning the import into the Community of preserved fruit salads originating  
in Morocco (1985)**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN  
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European  
Economic Community, and in particular Article 113  
thereof,

Having regard to the recommendation from the  
Commission,

Whereas the Cooperation Agreement between the  
European Economic Community and the Kingdom of  
Morocco (1<sup>o</sup>) was signed on 27 April 1976 and entered  
into force on 1 November 1978;

Whereas the Agreement in the form of an exchange of  
letters between the European Economic Community  
and the Kingdom of Morocco concerning the import  
into the Community of preserved fruit salads originating  
in Morocco should be approved,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

*Article 1*

The Agreement in the form of an exchange of letters  
between the European Economic Community and the

Kingdom of Morocco concerning the import into the  
Community of preserved fruit salads originating in  
Morocco is hereby approved on behalf of the Commu-  
nity.

The text of the Agreement is annexed to this Regula-  
tion.

*Article 2*

The President of the Council is hereby authorized to  
designate the person empowered to sign the Agree-  
ment for the purpose of binding the Community.

*Article 3*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day  
following its publication in the *Official Journal of the  
European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member  
States.
