

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 1583/86
of 23 May 1986
amending Regulation (EEC) No 3103/76 on aid for durum wheat

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in cereals ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1579/86 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 10 (4) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission ⁽³⁾,

Whereas, in accordance with Article 10 of Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75, aid is granted only for durum wheat produced in those areas of the Community where such production constitutes a traditional and major part of agricultural production; whereas application of this criterion means that production aid for durum wheat should be provided for in respect of durum wheat in Spain also in the provinces of Badajoz and Zaragoza;

Whereas the current arrangements to assist agriculture in mountain and hill-farming areas in less-favoured areas must be amplified and strengthened; whereas it is appropriate, to this end, to make provisions for including durum wheat in the list of products that may qualify for the support provided for by this new approach in structural policy; whereas, therefore, the aid for durum wheat provided, in the market organization, for

mountain and hill-farming areas and less-favoured areas covered by Directive 75/268/EEC ⁽⁴⁾ should be discontinued; whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 3103/76 ⁽⁵⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1455/82 ⁽⁶⁾, should be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

1. In the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 3103/76 the expression 'mountain and hill-farming areas, and less-favoured areas, covered by Directive 75/268/EEC' shall be deleted wherever it occurs.

2. In the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 3103/76 the 'SPAIN' section shall be replaced by the following:

'SPAIN

- Comunidad Autónoma: Andalucía
- Provincia: Burgos — Badajoz — Zaragoza'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

It shall apply from 1 July 1986.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
