

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 3302/87**of 3 November 1987****amending Regulation (EEC) No 3905/86 on the sale by tender, for export of beef
held by certain intervention agencies in Peru**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 467/87 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7 (3) thereof,Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 3905/86 ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2929/87 ⁽⁴⁾, provides for an export sale to Peru of hindquarters and forequarters from intervention;

Whereas Article 5 (1) of the same Regulation provides for the meat to be taken over by 30 November 1987; whereas that time limit should be extended;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal,

Article 1

Article 5 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 3905/86 reads as follows:

'1. The meat shall be taken over by the buyer within three months of the conclusion of the sales contract'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 4 November 1987.

It shall apply to contracts concluded from 4 November 1987.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
