

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1679/89
of 14 June 1989

**amending Regulation (EEC) No 2191/81 on the granting of aid for the purchase
of butter by non-profitmaking institutions and organizations**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 763/89⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 12 (3) thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2191/81⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 442/88⁽⁴⁾, provides for the granting of aid for the purchase of butter by non-profitmaking institutions and organizations; whereas, in view of the current situation on the market for

butter and the level of sales under that Regulation, the aid should be reduced;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Article 2 of Regulation (EEC) No 2191/81, '165 ECU' is hereby replaced by 'ECU 150'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
