

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 1055/90**of 27 April 1990****extending for the second time the 1989/1990 marketing year in the milk and beef
and veal sectors**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 763/89 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 2 thereof,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 571/89 ⁽⁴⁾, and in particular Article 4 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 788/90 ⁽⁵⁾ extends the 1989/90 marketing year in the milk and beef and veal sectors to 29 April 1990;

Whereas it has proved necessary to reconsider all the problems relating to the fixing of prices for the forth-

coming marketing year, which will involve delay in the fixing of those prices; whereas the 1989/1990 marketing year must therefore be extended in the milk and beef and veal sectors until 13 May 1990,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

1. The 1989/1990 milk year shall end on 13 May 1990 and the 1990/1991 milk year shall begin on 14 May 1990.

2. The 1989/1990 marketing year for beef and veal shall end on 13 May 1990 and the 1990/1991 marketing year shall begin on 14 May 1990.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 30 April 1990.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
