

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 3196/90
of 5 November 1990
concerning the stopping of fishing for mackerel by vessels flying the flag of Denmark

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2241/87 of 23 July 1987 establishing certain control measures for fishing activities ⁽¹⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3483/88 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 11 (3) thereof,

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 4053/89 of 19 December 1989 allocating, for 1990, certain catch quotas between the Member States for vessels fishing in Faroese waters ⁽³⁾ provides for mackerel quotas for 1990;

Whereas, in order to ensure compliance with the provisions relating to the quantitative limitations on catches of stocks subject to quotas, it is necessary for the Commission to fix the date by which catches made by vessels flying the flag of a Member State are deemed to have exhausted the quota allocated;

Whereas, according to the information communicated to the Commission, catches of mackerel in Faroese waters by vessels flying the flag of Denmark or registered in Denmark have reached the quota allocated for 1990;

whereas Denmark has prohibited fishing for this stock as from 23 October 1990; whereas it is therefore necessary to abide by that date,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Catches of mackerel in Faroese waters by vessels flying the flag of Denmark or registered in Denmark are deemed to have exhausted the quota allocated to Denmark for 1990.

Fishing for mackerel in Faroese waters by vessels flying the flag of Denmark or registered in Denmark is prohibited, as well as the retention on board, the transshipment and the landing of such stock captured by the abovementioned vessels after the date of application of this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

It shall apply with effect from 23 October 1990.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
