

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 159/91**

of 23 January 1991

**altering the export refunds on white sugar and raw sugar exported in the natural state**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1785/81 of 30 June 1981 on the common organization of the markets in the sugar sector <sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3577/90 <sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular the second subparagraph of Article 19 <sup>(4)</sup> thereof,Whereas the refunds on white sugar and raw sugar exported in the natural state were fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 100/91 <sup>(3)</sup>, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 133/91 <sup>(4)</sup>;

Whereas it follows from applying the detailed rules contained in Regulation (EEC) No 100/91 to the informa-

tion known to the Commission that the export refunds at present in force should be altered to the amounts set out in the Annex hereto,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

The export refunds on the products listed in Article 1 (1) (a) of Regulation (EEC) No 1785/81, undenatured and exported in the natural state, as fixed in the Annex to amended Regulation (EEC) No 100/91 are hereby altered to the amounts shown in the Annex hereto.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 24 January 1991.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
