COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 2979/94**of 6 December 1994****repealing Regulation (EC) No 1399/94 concerning the stopping of fishing for cod
by vessels flying the flag of Germany**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,
Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2847/93
of 12 October 1993 establishing a control system appli-
cable to the common fisheries policy ⁽¹⁾, and in particular
Article 21 (3) thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EC) No 1399/94 ⁽²⁾
stopped fishing for cod in the waters of ICES division
III a Kattegat by vessels flying the flag of Germany or
registered in Germany;

Whereas, on 22 September 1994, Denmark transferred to
Germany 10 tonnes of cod in the waters of ICES division
III a Kattegat; Whereas, on 25 October 1994, Denmark
transferred to Germany 10 tonnes of cod in the waters of
ICES division III a Kattegat; whereas fishing for cod in

the waters of ICES division III a Kattegat by vessels flying
the flag of Germany or registered in Germany should
therefore be permitted; whereas consequently it is neces-
sary to repeal Regulation (EC) No 1399/94,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Regulation (EC) No 1399/94 is hereby repealed.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day
following its publication in the *Official Journal of the
European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
