

COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 1292/2002**of 16 July 2002****laying down to what extent applications for issue of export licences submitted during July 2002 for beef products which may benefit from special import treatment in a third country may be accepted**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

*Article 1*Having regard to Commission Regulation (EC) No 1445/95 of 26 June 1995 on rules of application for import and export licences in the beef sector and repealing Regulation (EEC) No 2377/80 ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 2492/2001 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 12(8) thereof,

No applications for export licences were lodged for the beef referred to in Regulation (EEC) No 2973/79 for the third quarter of 2002.

Whereas:

Article 2(1) Regulation (EC) No 1445/95 lays down, in Article 12, detailed rules for export licence applications for the products referred to in Article 1 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2973/79 ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3434/87 ⁽⁴⁾.

Applications for licences in respect of the meat referred to in Article 1 may be lodged in accordance with Article 12 of Regulation (EC) No 1445/95 during the first 10 days of the fourth quarter of 2002 the total quantity available being 5 000 t.

(2) Regulation (EEC) No 2973/79 fixed the quantities of meat which might be exported on special terms for the third quarter of 2002. No applications were submitted for export licences for beef,

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on 17 July 2002.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
