

COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) 2023/1570**of 23 May 2023****correcting the Hungarian language version of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/689 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards rules for surveillance, eradication programmes, and disease-free status for certain listed and emerging diseases****(Text with EEA relevance)**

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2016 on transmissible animal diseases and amending and repealing certain acts in the area of animal health ('Animal Health Law') ⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 42(6) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) The Hungarian language version of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/689 ⁽²⁾ contains an error in Part I, Chapter 1, Section 3, point 1, introductory phrase, of Annex IV that alters the meaning of the provision.
- (2) The Hungarian language version of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/689 should therefore be corrected accordingly. The other language versions are not affected,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

(Does not concern the English language.)

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
