

KOMMISSIONENS FORORDNING (EF) Nr. 1536/2003**af 29. august 2003****om ændring af Rådets forordning (EF) nr. 2368/2002 om gennemførelse af Kimberley-processens certificeringsordning for international handel med uslebne diamanter**

KOMMISSIONEN FOR DE EUROPÆISKE FÆLLESSKABER HAR —

under henvisning til traktaten om oprettelse af Det Europæiske Fællesskab,

under henvisning til Rådets forordning (EF) nr. 2368/2002 af 20. december 2002 om gennemførelse af Kimberley-processens certificeringsordning for international handel med uslebne diamanter⁽¹⁾, senest ændret ved Kommissionens forordning (EF) nr. 1214/2003⁽²⁾, særlig artikel 20, og

ud fra følgende betragtninger:

- (1) I henhold til artikel 20 i forordning (EF) nr. 2368/2002 kan listen over deltagende parter i Kimberley-processens certificeringsordning, herunder WTO-medlemmer og særskilte toldområder, der opfylder kravene i ordningen, ændres.
- (2) Formandskabet for Kimberley-processens certificeringsordning har i meddelelse af 31. juli 2003 forelagt en ajourført liste over de deltagende parter. Ajourføringen

af listen, som får virkning den 1. september 2003, vedrører navnlig tilføjelse af Kroatien som deltagende part og fjernelse af Algeriet, Brasilien, Burkina Faso, Cameroun, Cypern, Filippinerne, Gabon, Ghana, Malaysia, Mali, Malta, Mexico, Nordkorea, Norge, Swaziland, Tjekkiet, Togo, Tunesien, Tyrkiet og Vietnam. Bilag II skal derfor ændres i overensstemmelse hermed —
