Invitation to tender No 1215 issued by the Republic of Dahomey, published in the *Official Journal of the European Communities* No C 180 of 7 August 1975, for the provision of equipment for 2 000 user connections as part of the extension of the water supply network in the town of Cotonou,

Notice of invitation to tender for the levy and/or the refund for the export of wholly milled long grain rice to third countries**I. Subject**

1. Tenders are invited for the levy and/or the refund for the export to third countries of wholly milled long grain rice falling within subheading 10.06 B II b) of the Common Customs Tariff.
2. The total quantity in respect of which there may be fixed a minimum export levy and/or a maximum export refund as provided in Article 5 (1) of Commission Regulations (EEC) No 3197/73 ⁽¹⁾ and (EEC) No 584/75 ⁽²⁾ is approximately 20 000 metric tons.
3. The invitation to tender will be conducted in accordance with the provisions of:

- Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2454/75 ⁽⁸⁾ of 26 September 1975.

II. Time limits

1. The period for the receipt of tenders for the first of the weekly awards will begin on the day following that on which this notice is published in the *Official Journal of the European Communities* and will expire at 10 a.m. on the first Thursday following the expiry of 10 days from that day.
