DECISION No 4/93 OF THE EEC-ICELAND JOINT COMMITTEE

of 5 July 1993

amending Protocol 3 concerning the definition of the concept of 'originating products' and methods of administrative cooperation

(94/105/EC)

THE JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Republic of Iceland, signed in Brussels on 22 July 1972,

Having regard to Protocol 3 concerning the definition of the concept of 'originating products' and methods of administrative cooperation, hereinafter referred to as 'Protocol 3', and in particular Article 28 thereof,

Whereas the rule of origin in the list in Annex III to Protocol 3 applicable to toys; reduced-size ('scale') models and similar recreational models, working or not; puzzles of all kinds, of HS heading No 9503 lays down that all the materials used are classified within a heading other than that of the product and the value of all the materials used does not exceed 50% of the ex works price of the product;

Whereas it is appropriate to amend the origin rule applicable to constructional toys of plastics of HS heading No 9503 in order to authorize the use of materials classified within the same heading as the product up to a value of 10% of the ex works price of the product, and within the 50% limit concerning all the materials used already laid down in the actual rule,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The heading and relevant rules in the list annexed to this Decision shall replace the corresponding heading and rule in the list in Annex III to Protocol 3 to the EEC—Iceland Agreement.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption.

It shall apply with effect from 1 January 1993.
