DECISION OF THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE No 130/2005

of 21 October 2005

amending Annex I (Veterinary and phytosanitary matters) to the EEA Agreement

THE EEA JOINT COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, as amended by the Protocol adjusting the Agreement on the European Economic Area, hereinafter referred to as 'the Agreement', and in particular Article 98 thereof,

Whereas:

- Annex I to the Agreement was amended by Decision of the EEA Joint Committee No 109/2005 (1). (1)
- (2) Commission Regulation (EC) No 521/2005 of 1 April 2005 concerning the permanent authorisation of an additive and the provisional authorisation of new uses of certain additives already authorised in feedingstuffs (2) is to be incorporated into the Agreement.
- Commission Regulation (EC) No 600/2005 of 18 April 2005 concerning a new authorisation for 10 (3) years of a coccidiostat as an additive in feedingstuffs, the provisional authorisation of an additive and the permanent authorisation of certain additives in feedingstuffs (3) is to be incorporated into the Agreement,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The following points shall be inserted after point 1zzh (Commission Regulation (EC) No 378/2005) of Chapter II of Annex I to the Agreement:

- 1zzi. 32005 R 0521: Commission Regulation (EC) No 521/2005 of 1 April 2005 concerning the permanent authorisation of an additive and the provisional authorisation of new uses of certain additives already authorised in feedingstuffs (OJ L 84, 2.4.2005, p. 3).
- **32005 R 0600:** Commission Regulation (EC) No 600/2005 of 18 April 2005 concerning a new authorisation for 10 years of a coccidiostat as an additive in feedingstuffs, the provisional authorisation of an additive and the permanent authorisation of certain additives in feedingstuffs (OJ L 99, 19.4.2005, p. 5).'
