REGULATION (EEC) No 2204/69 OF THE COMMISSION

of 5 November 1969

amending Regulation No 158/67/EEC determining the coefficients of equivalence between the different qualities of cereals

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/EEC¹ of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in cereals, as last amended by Regulations (EEC) Nos 1396/69² and 1398/69,³ and in particular Article 13 (4) thereof;

Whereas Commission Regulation No 158/67/EEC⁴ of 23 June 1967 determining the coefficients of equivalence between the qualities of cereals offered on the world market and the standard quality for which the threshold price is fixed, as last amended by

Regulation (EEC) No 405/69,5 determined the coefficients of equivalence for certain qualities of cereals offered on the world market;

Whereas Spanish oats which do not appear in the Annex to Regulation No 158/67/EEC are sometimes offered on the world market;

Whereas, with a view to determining c.i.f. prices, it is necessary to fix a coefficient of equivalence for that quality in the light both of the standard Community quality and of the differences in price and characteristics between Spanish oats and the qualities listed in the Annex to Regulation No 158/67/EEC;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The following shall be added to the 'Oats' section of the Annex to Regulation No 158/67/EEC:
