

REGULATION (ECSC, EEC, EURATOM) No 2647/72 OF THE COUNCIL
of 12 December 1972

adjusting the remuneration and pensions of officials of the European Com-
adjusting and the remuneration of other servants of the Communities

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing a Single Council and a Single Commission of the European Communities;

Having regard to Regulation (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 259/68¹ of the Council of 28 February 1968, laying down the Staff Regulations of officials and the conditions of employment of other servants of the European Communities and instituting special measures temporarily applicable to officials of the Commission, as last amended by Regulation (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 1473/72² of the Council of 30 June 1972, and in particular Articles 2 and 3 thereof and Articles 64, 65 and 82 of the Staff Regulations of officials of the European Communities and Articles 20 (1) and 64 of the Conditions of Employment of other servants of the Community;

Having regard to Regulation (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 600/72³ of the Council of 23 March 1972 adjusting the weightings applicable to the remuneration and pensions of officials and other servants of the European Communities;

Having regard to Regulation (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 1725/72⁴ of the Council of 1 August 1972 adjusting the weightings applicable to the remuneration of officials and other servants of the European Communities working in Switzerland;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas after examining the level of remuneration of officials and other servants, it is regarded as appropriate to adjust the remuneration and pensions of officials and other servants of the European Communities on the basis of the report drawn up by the Commission;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

With effect from 1 July 1972, the Staff Regulations and Annex VII thereto are amended as follows:

1. The following shall be substituted for the table of basic monthly salaries in Article 66:

2. (a) '1 183 Belgian Francs' shall be substituted for '1 127 Belgian francs' in Article 67 (1) (a) of the Staff Regulations and in Article 1 (1) of Annex VII thereto;
- (b) '1 839 Belgian francs' shall be substituted for '1 752 Belgian francs' in Article 67 (1) (b) of the Staff Regulations and in Article 2 (1) of Annex VII thereto;
- (c) '3 284 Belgian francs' shall be substituted for '3 129 Belgian francs' in the second sentence of Article 69 of the Staff Regulations and in the third paragraph of Article 3 and the last subparagraph of Article 4 (1) of Annex VII thereto;

- (d) '1 642 Belgian francs' shall be substituted for '1 565 Belgian francs' in the first paragraph of Article 3 of Annex VII.

Article 2

With effect from 1 July 1972 the Conditions of Employment applicable to Other Servants of the European Communities shall be amended as follows:

The following shall be substituted for the table of basic monthly salaries in Article 63:

Article 3

1. With effect from 1 January 1972 the temporary fixed allowance referred to in Article 4a of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations shall be:

- 855 Belgian francs per month for officials in Grade C 4 or C 5;
- 1 314 Belgian francs per month for officials in Grade C 1, C 2 or C 3.

2. The temporary fixed allowance referred to in Article 4a of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations shall be granted until 30 June 1974.

Article 4

Pensions payable on 1 July 1972 shall be calculated from that date by reference to the table of basic monthly salaries laid down in Article 66 of the Staff Regulations as amended by Article 1 (1) of this Regulation.

Article 5

1. For the period 1 July to 30 September 1971 the weightings to be applied to the remuneration of officials employed in any of the countries specified below shall be as follows:

Belgium	108.90%
Federal Republic of Germany	103.98%
France	130.43%
Italy	105.48%
Grand Duchy of Luxembourg	108.90%
Netherlands	109.56%
United Kingdom	116.98%
Switzerland	105.26%

2. With effect from 1 July 1972 the weightings to be applied to pensions in accordance with the second subparagraph of Article 82 (1) of the Staff Regulations shall be that laid down below for the Community country where the person entitled to the pension declares his home to be:

Belgium	108.90%
Federal Republic of Germany	103.98%
France	130.43%
Italy	105.48%
Grand Duchy of Luxembourg	108.90%
Netherlands	109.56%

If the person entitled to the pension declares his home to be in a country other than those mentioned above, the weighting to be applied to the pension shall be that for Belgium.

Article 6

For every month in the period from 1 January to 30 June 1972, officials shall receive a payment amounting to 1.85% of the basic salary to which they were entitled for these months.

Article 7

With effect from 1 July 1972 Articles 6 to 10 of Regulation (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 2653/71, Regulation (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 600/72 and Regulation (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 1725/72 are repealed.

Article 8

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
