

REGULATION (EEC) No 1346/74 OF THE COMMISSION
of 30 May 1974
amending Regulation (EEC) No 1294/74 introducing a countervailing charge on
tomatoes imported from Bulgaria and Romania

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1035/72 ⁽¹⁾ of 18 May 1972 on the common organization of the market in fruit and vegetables, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2745/72 ⁽²⁾, and in particular the second subparagraph of Article 27 (2) thereof;

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 1294/74 ⁽³⁾ introduced a countervailing charge on tomatoes imported from Bulgaria and Romania;

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 1035/72 laid down the conditions under which a charge is introduced, amended or abolished; whereas, if these conditions are taken into consideration the countervailing charge

on tomatoes imported from Bulgaria must be abolished and the countervailing charge on tomatoes imported from Romania must be amended,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Article 1 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1294/74 is replaced by the following:

- '1. A countervailing charge of 26.5 units of account per 100 kg net is applied to tomatoes (subheading No 07.01 M of Common Customs Tariff) imported from Romania.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 31 May 1974.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
