

REGULATION (EEC) No 1862/74 OF THE COUNCIL
of 15 July 1974
amending Regulation (EEC) No 765/68 laying down general rules for the produc-
tion refund on sugar used in the chemical industry

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 1009/
67/EEC⁽¹⁾ of 18 December 1967 on the common
organization of the market in sugar, as last amended
by Regulation (EEC) No 1602/74⁽²⁾, and in particular
Article 9 (7) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas Article 5 (1) of Council Regulation (EEC) No
765/68⁽³⁾ of 18 June 1968 laying down general rules
for the production refund on sugar used in the chemi-
cal industry, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No
2723/71⁽⁴⁾, has fixed the production refund, appli-
cable until 30 June 1975 to sugar used in the manufac-
ture of certain chemical products which may be
derived either from sugar or starchy raw materials, at
an amount equal to the intervention price of the
processing area less an amount of 13.30 units of
account per 100 kilogrammes; whereas this amount
was calculated bearing in mind the need to discourage
the use of cereals in the manufacture of the chemical
products;

Whereas, at the same time as the amount of 13.30
units of account was fixed, the maize supply price for
the calculation of the production refund for the
cereals sector was fixed at 6.80 units of account per
100 kilogrammes; whereas pursuant to Council Regu-
lation (EEC) No 1132/74⁽⁵⁾ of 29 April 1974 on
production refunds in the cereals and rice sectors, this
maize supply price will be raised from 1 August 1974
to 8.20 units of account per 100 kilogrammes;
whereas consequently this amount of 13.30 units of
account has to be revised from the same date in
keeping with this increase,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Article 5 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 765/68 the
amount of '13.30 units of account' shall be replaced
by the amount of '16.00 units of account'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 August
1974.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
