

REGULATION (EEC) No 1916/74 OF THE COMMISSION
of 23 July 1974
altering the corrective amount applicable to the refund on cereals

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/
67/EEC ⁽¹⁾ of 13 June 1967 on the common organiza-
tion of the market in cereals, as last amended by Regu-
lation (EEC) No 1346/73 ⁽²⁾, and in particular the
second sentence of the first subparagraph of Article
16(4) thereof;

Whereas, the corrective amount applicable to the
refund on cereals was fixed by Regulation (EEC) No
1866/74 ⁽³⁾ and subsequent amending Regulations;

Whereas, on the basis of today's cif prices and cif
forward delivery prices, taking foreseeable develop-

ments on the market into account, the corrective
amount at present applicable to the refund on cereals
should be altered,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The corrective amount referred to in Article 16(4) of
Regulation No 120/67/EEC which is applicable to the
export refunds fixed in advance in respect of cereals is
hereby altered as shown in the Table annexed to this
Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 24 July
1974.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
