COUNCIL DECISION

of 26 May 1975

on the conclusion of the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Catholic Relief Service on the supply of common wheat flour as food aid

(75/418/EEC)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Articles 113, 114 and 228 thereof;

Having regard to the recommendation from the Commission;

Whereas the European Economic Community has concluded the 1971 Food Aid Convention;

Whereas the Catholic Relief Service has provided information about the needs, in cereals, of vulnerable groups of persons in Chile; whereas this organization should be accorded, by way of gift, 11 952 metric tons of common wheat in the form of 7 915 metric tons of common wheat flour under the Community's food-aid programme for 1972/73,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Catholic Relief Service on the supply of common wheat flour as food aid is hereby concluded on behalf of the Community.

The text of the Agreement is annexed to this Decision.

Article 2

The President of the Council is hereby authorized to designate the persons empowered to sign the Agreement and to confer on them the necessary powers to bind the Community.
