## **REGULATION (EEC) No 119/75 OF THE COMMISSION**

### of 17 January 1975

#### fixing the amounts applicable as compensatory amounts for pigmeat

# THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty (<sup>1</sup>) concerning the accession of new Member States to the European Economic Community, and the European Atomic Energy Community, signed at Brussels on 22 January 1972;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 234/73 (<sup>2</sup>) of 31 January 1973 laying down general rules for a system of compensatory amounts for pigmeat, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2879/73 (<sup>3</sup>), and in particular Article 8 (3) thereof;

Whereas compensatory amounts for pigmeat products were laid down in Council Regulation (EEC) No 234/73 and Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1922/74 (<sup>4</sup>) of 23 July 1974, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2518/74 (<sup>5</sup>); whereas, however, if the situation referred to in Article 7 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 229/73 (<sup>6</sup>) of 31 January 1973 laying down general rules for a system of compensatory amounts for cereals should arise, the amounts applicable as compensatory amounts, except from the amounts for products falling under subheading 15.01 A of the Common Customs Tariff, are fixed in accordance with Article 3 of Regulation (EEC) No 234/73; Whereas in the sector of pigmeat the calculation of the compensatory amounts results in minimal amounts; whereas there is therefore no need to fix compensatory amounts,

#### HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

# Article 1

1. The amounts referred to in Article 3 of Regulation (EEC) No 234/73 and applicable as compensatory amounts for pigmeat for the period 1 February 1975 to 30 April 1975 are fixed at 0, except for amounts for products falling under subheading 15.01 A of the Common Customs Tariff.

2. The amounts applicable as compensatory amounts for products falling under subheading 15.01 A of the Common Customs Tariff are determined in the Annex.

# Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 February 1975.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

2. According to the provisions of Article 55 (6) of the Act concerning the conditions of accession and the adjustments to the Treaties the compensatory amount levied or granted by a Member State may not exceed the total amount levied by that same Member State on imports from third countries.
