

REGULATION (EEC) No 1056/75 OF THE COMMISSION

of 23 April 1975

amending the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 1014/75 on the opening of an invitation to tender for the mobilization of round grain milled rice as food aid for the International Committee of the Red Cross

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community ;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 359/67/EEC⁽¹⁾ of 25 July 1967 on the common organization of the market in rice, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 668/75⁽²⁾;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1693/72⁽³⁾ of 3 August 1972 laying down the conditions for the mobilization of cereals as food aid, and in particular Article 6 thereof ;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1014/75⁽⁴⁾ of 18 April 1975 on the opening of an invitation to tender for the mobilization of round grain milled rice as food aid for the International Committee of the Red Cross fixed, in the Annex, Saigon, Haiphon/Danang as unloading ports ; whereas

it has been shown that these ports are difficult to reach ; whereas it is advisable to replace them with the port of Singapore for lots 1 and 2 ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 1014/75 shall be replaced by the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
