## REGULATION (EEC) No 3192/75 OF THE COMMISSION

#### of 5 December 1975

amending Regulation (EEC) No 232/75 as regards the age of the butter put up for sale, and Regulation (EEC) No 1282/72 as regards the application of the export refunds

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 (1) of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 740/75 (2), and in particular Article 6 (7) thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 985/68 (3) of 15 July 1968 laying down general rules for intervention on the market in butter and cream, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2714/72 (4), and in particular Article 7a thereof;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 232/75 (5) of 30 January 1975 on the sale of butter at reduced prices for use in the manufacture of pastry products and ice cream, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2927/75 (6), provides that the butter put up for sale must have been taken into storage before 1 July 1975; whereas, having regard to the butter storage position in the Community, this date should be altered;

Whereas the amended wording of Article 8 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1282/72 (7) of 21 June 1972 on the sale of butter at a reduced price to the army and similar forces, as set out in Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 2586/75 (8), erroneously failed to provide that refunds for the butter in question should not apply; whereas therefore an addition should be made to the text in force since 13 October 1975;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

#### Article 1

In Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 232/75 the date '1 July 1975' is replaced by '1 October 1975'.

### Article 2

There shall be added to Article 8 of Regulation (EEC) No 1282/72 the following subparagraph:

'(c) no refund shall be granted.'

# Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
