

REGULATION (EEC) No 3295/75 OF THE COMMISSION**of 18 December 1975****amending Regulation (EEC) No 2115/75 laying down in respect of the 1975/76 wine-growing year detailed rules for applying the obligation to distil the by-products of wine-making and repealing Regulation (EEC) No 2179/74**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community ;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 816/70⁽¹⁾ of 28 April 1970 laying down additional provisions for the common organization of the market in wine, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1932/75⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 24 (4) thereof ;

Whereas Article 7 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2115/75⁽³⁾ of 12 August 1975 laying down in respect of the 1975/76 wine-growing year detailed rules for applying the obligation to distil the by-products of wine-making and repealing Regulation (EEC) No 2179/74 set the period for the distillation of wine compulsorily delivered at between 1 April 1976 and 16 August 1976 ; whereas that operation should be commenced earlier in order to avoid technical difficulties during distillation ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Wine,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

In Article 7 of Regulation (EEC) No 2115/75, the phrase 'between 1 April 1976 and 16 August 1976' is replaced by 'between 1 January 1976 and 16 August 1976'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
