

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1902/76
of 30 July 1976
amending for the seventh time Regulation (EEC) No 2042/75 on special detailed
rules for the application of the system of import and export licences for cereals
and rice

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No
2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organiza-
tion of the market in cereals⁽¹⁾, as last amended by
Regulation (EEC) No 1143/76⁽²⁾, and in particular
Article 12 (2) thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2042/75
of 25 July 1975 on special detailed rules for the appli-
cation of the system of import and export licences for
cereals and rice⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation
(EEC) No 1381/76⁽⁴⁾, provided for a period of validity
of 30 days for import licences for feed grains;

Whereas following the drought in several regions of
the Community there has been a drop in the availa-
bility of fodder supplies and an increase in prices;
whereas to deal with this situation imports of certain
feed grains should be facilitated by extending the
period of validity of import licences therefor; whereas
this increase may be greater in the short term in view
of the supply situation at the beginning of the
1976/77 marketing year;

Whereas with an increased period of validity of
import licences the levy can be fixed in advance for a
longer period; whereas any ensuing risks to the
management of the market may be reduced by
increasing the security to be deposited to obtain the
licence;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation
are in accordance with the opinion of the Manage-
ment Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Article 12 (1) (b) of Regulation (EEC) No 2042/75 is
amended to read as follows :

- '(b) three units of account per metric ton for
import licences in respect of products for
which the import levy is fixed in advance,
with the exception of import certificates for
products falling within subheading 10.05 B
and heading No 10.07 of the Common
Customs Tariff for which the rate of security
is six units of account per metric ton.'

Article 2

Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 2042/75 is amended
as follows :

- from the date of entry into force of this Regulation
until 31 August 1976, as shown in Annex I to this
Regulation,
- with effect from 1 September 1976, as shown in
Annex II to this Regulation.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its
publication in the *Official Journal of the European
Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
