

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 736/77**of 6 April 1977****amending Regulation (EEC) No 572/76 as regards the monetary compensatory amounts applicable to certain pigmeat products**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 of 12 May 1971 on certain measures of conjunctural policy to be taken in agriculture following the temporary widening of the margins of fluctuation for the currencies of certain Member States⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 557/76⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 6 thereof,

Whereas the monetary compensatory amounts introduced by Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 were fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 572/76 of 15 March 1976⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 735/77⁽⁴⁾;

Whereas certain products are by reason of their presentation classified under tariff subheadings for which the monetary amounts are extremely high; whereas, as a result, those products may be exported or imported for the sole purpose of obtaining monetary compensa-

tory amounts; whereas, therefore, the amounts in question should no longer be applied to the products concerned;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Pigmeat,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Part 2 of Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 572/76 the following footnote⁽⁴⁾ is added in respect of tariff subheadings 02.06 B I b) 7 aa) and bb):

'⁽⁴⁾ Monetary compensatory amounts shall not apply to products presented in the form of meal or powder.'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
