### COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 736/77

# of 6 April 1977

# amending Regulation (EEC) No 572/76 as regards the monetary compensatory amounts applicable to certain pigmeat products

# THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 of 12 May 1971 on certain measures of conjunctural policy to be taken in agriculture following the temporary widening of the margins of fluctuation for the currencies of certain Member States (<sup>1</sup>), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 557/76 (<sup>2</sup>), and in particular Article 6 thereof,

Whereas the monetary compensatory amounts introduced by Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 were fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 572/76 of 15 March 1976 (<sup>3</sup>), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 735/77 (<sup>4</sup>);

Whereas certain products are by reason of their presentation classified under tariff subheadings for which the monetary amounts are extremely high; whereas, as a result, those products may be exported or imported for the sole purpose of obtaining monetary compensatory amounts; whereas, therefore, the amounts in question should no longer be applied to the products concerned;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Pigmeat,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

#### Article 1

In Part 2 of Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 572/76 the following footnote (<sup>4</sup>) is added in respect of tariff subheadings 02.06 B I b) 7 aa) and bb):

'(4) Monetary compensatory amounts shall not apply to products presented in the form of meal or powder.'

# Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
