

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 2365/77
of 28 October 1977

suspending application of the condition to which the importation into the Community of certain types of citrus fruit originating in Spain or in Cyprus is subject by virtue of the Agreements between the Community and those countries

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament ⁽¹⁾,

Whereas Article 7 (2) and (3) of Annex I to the Agreement between the European Economic Community and Spain ⁽²⁾ and Article 5 (2) and (3) of Annex I to the Agreement establishing an Association between the European Economic Community and the Republic of Cyprus ⁽³⁾ lay down, in respect of imports into the Community of certain types of fresh citrus fruit falling within subheadings 08.02 A I or ex B of the Common Customs Tariff and originating in the two aforementioned countries, arrangements involving a tariff reduction subject, during the period of application of reference prices, to the observance of a specified price on the Community internal market;

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 2047/70 of 13 October 1970 on imports of citrus fruit originating in Spain ⁽⁴⁾ and Council Regulation (EEC) No 1252/73 of 14 May 1973 on imports of citrus fruit originating in Cyprus ⁽⁵⁾ laid down detailed rules for applying these provisions;

Whereas application of the condition for the tariff reduction should be suspended in respect of imports of certain types of fresh citrus fruit falling within subheadings 08.02 A I or ex B and originating in Spain or Cyprus;

Whereas application of Regulations (EEC) No 2047/70 and (EEC) No 1252/73 should therefore also be suspended,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

For the following products:

CCT heading No	Description of goods
08.02	Citrus fruit, fresh or dried : A. Oranges : I. Sweet oranges, fresh ex B. Fresh mandarins (including tangerines and satsumas); fresh clementines, wilkings and other similar citrus hybrids

originating in Spain or Cyprus, application of the following provisions is hereby suspended:

- Article 7 (2) and (3) of Annex I to the Agreement between the European Economic Community and Spain,
- Article 5 (2) and (3) of Annex I to the Agreement establishing an Association between the European Economic Community and the Republic of Cyprus.

Article 2

Application of Regulations (EEC) No 2047/70 and (EEC) No 1252/73 is hereby suspended in respect of the products specified in Article 1 originating in Spain or Cyprus.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

It shall be applicable for the second half of 1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
