

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 353/78
of 20 February 1978

temporarily and partially suspending the autonomous Common Customs Tariff duty on sardinops sagax or ocellata (pilchards), fresh, chilled or frozen, whole, headless or in pieces, intended for the processing industry, falling within subheading ex 03.01 B I q)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 28 thereof,

Having regard to the draft Regulation from the Commission,

Whereas, as a consequence of the ban on herring fishing, it has become especially difficult to supply certain Community processing industries with sufficient quantities of their raw material ;

Whereas to facilitate such supplies, it is advisable to extend until 30 June 1978, as regards pilchards falling within subheading ex 03.01 B I q), the suspension of the Common Customs Tariff duty introduced by Council Regulation (EEC) No 2622/77 of 28 November 1977 suspending the Common Customs Tariff duties on a number of agricultural products⁽¹⁾,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The autonomous Common Customs Tariff duty on the product listed below shall be suspended at the level of 4 % from 1 March to 30 June 1978.

ex 03.01 B I q)	Sardinops sagax or ocellata (pilchards), fresh, chilled or frozen, whole, headless or in pieces, intended for the processing industry (a)

(a) This suspension is subject to conditions to be determined by the competent authorities.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 March 1978.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
