

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1111/78
of 26 May 1978
adopting exceptional support measures for the market in pigmeat

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2759/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in pigmeat⁽¹⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 367/76⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 20 thereof,

Whereas because of the health situation in the breeding sector in Sardinia, the export of live pigs and of pigmeat coming from this region of Italy has become temporarily impossible;

Whereas, in order to take account of the limitations to free circulation which are resulting from this, exceptional measures to support the market in Sardinia must be taken;

Whereas for this purpose there is reason to fix private storage aid for certain sensitive products according to detailed rules of application for the grant of private storage aid in the pigmeat sector which have been adopted by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1889/76 of 29 July 1976⁽³⁾;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Pigmeat,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

1. From 29 May until 17 June 1978 the Italian intervention agency can grant private storage aid in

the pigmeat sector following the detailed rules defined in Regulation (EEC) No 1889/76 and in this Regulation.

Only products coming from pigs originating in Sardinia can be the subject of this aid.

The list of products which qualify for aid and the amounts involved are set out in the Annex.

2. If the period of storage is extended or curtailed the amount of the aid shall be adjusted accordingly. The amounts of the supplements per month and the deductions per day are set out in columns 7 and 8 of the Annex.

Article 2

The minimum quantities per contract and per product shall be as follows:

- (a) 20 tonnes for carcasses,
- (b) 10 tonnes for hams, shoulders, loins and bellies (streaky).

Article 3

Placing in storage shall be completed within 21 days following conclusion of the contract.

Article 4

The security shall be 20 % of the amounts of aid set out in the Annex.

Article 5

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
