COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1520/78

of 30 June 1978

repealing Regulation (EEC) No 459/76 establishing a system of minimum prices applicable to tomato concentrates originating in Greece

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 516/77 of 14 March 1977 on the common organization of the market in products processed from fruit and vegetables (1), as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1152/78 (2), and in particular Article 14 (2) thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 459/76 of 27 February 1976 (3), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 436/78 (4), adopted a system of minimum prices applicable to the importation of tomato concentrates originating in Greece;

Whereas the conditions for the application of this system no longer exist; whereas consequently Regulation (EEC) No 459/76 should be repealed,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 459/76 is hereby repealed.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 July 1978.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
