

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1811/78
of 28 July 1978
abolishing the export levies for starch products based on rice

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No
1418/76 of 21 June 1976 on the common organiza-
tion of the market in rice ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regu-
lation (EEC) No 1126/78 ⁽²⁾,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No
2742/75 of 29 October 1975 on production refunds in
the cereals and rice sectors ⁽³⁾, as last amended by
Regulation (EEC) No 1127/78 ⁽⁴⁾, and in particular
Article 6 (2) thereof,

Having regard to the opinion of the Monetary
Committee,

Whereas the export levies on starch products manufac-
tured from rice were fixed by Regulation (EEC) No

1208/78 ⁽⁵⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No
1711/78 ⁽⁶⁾;

Whereas application of the criteria mentioned in
Regulation (EEC) No 1208/78 to the prices of broken
rice has the effect of abolishing the export levies for
starch products based on rice,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Export levies for the products falling within
subheading 11.08 A II of the Common Customs
Tariff are hereby abolished.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 29 July
1978.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
