

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2123/78
of 7 September 1978
amending Regulation (EEC) No 1937/78 introducing a countervailing charge on
peaches originating in Greece

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No
1035/72 of 18 May 1972 on the common organization
of the market in fruit and vegetables⁽¹⁾, as last
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1766/78⁽²⁾, and in
particular Article 27 (2) thereof,

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 1937/78⁽³⁾, as last
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2089/78⁽⁴⁾, intro-
duced a countervailing charge on peaches originating
in Greece ;

Whereas Article 26 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No
1035/72 laid down the conditions under which a

charge introduced in application of Article 25 of that
Regulation is amended ; whereas, if these conditions
are taken into consideration, the countervailing charge
on the import of peaches originating in Greece must
be amended,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The amount '23.15 units of account' appearing in
Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 1937/78 is replaced
by the amount '33.43 units of account'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 8 September
1978.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
