COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 147/79

of 26 January 1979

correcting Regulation (EEC) No 1036/78 fixing the monetary compensatory amounts

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 of 12 May 1971 on certain measures of conjunctural policy to be taken in agriculture following the temporary widening of the margin of fluctuation for the currencies of certain Member States (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 557/76 (2), and in particular Article 3 thereof,

Whereas the monetary compensatory amounts provided for in Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 were fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1036/78 of 19 May 1978 (3), as amended with effect from 4 December 1978 by Regulation (EEC) No 2827/78 (4);

Whereas a check has revealed errors in the Annex to that Regulation; whereas the Regulation in question must therefore be corrected,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Part 8 of Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 1036/78, the amount '7,893' under subheading 19.08 B III c) 2 is replaced by '7,898'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 27 January 1979. Where any party concerned so requests, it shall be applied from 4 December 1978 to 22 January 1979.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
