

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 147/79
of 26 January 1979
correcting Regulation (EEC) No 1036/78 fixing the monetary compensatory
amounts

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No
974/71 of 12 May 1971 on certain measures of
conjunctural policy to be taken in agriculture
following the temporary widening of the margin of
fluctuation for the currencies of certain Member
States⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No
557/76⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 3 thereof,

Whereas the monetary compensatory amounts
provided for in Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 were
fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1036/78
of 19 May 1978⁽³⁾, as amended with effect from 4
December 1978 by Regulation (EEC) No 2827/78⁽⁴⁾;

Whereas a check has revealed errors in the Annex to
that Regulation; whereas the Regulation in question
must therefore be corrected,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Part 8 of Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 1036/78,
the amount '7,893' under subheading 19.08 B III c) 2
is replaced by '7,898'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 27 January
1979. Where any party concerned so requests, it shall
be applied from 4 December 1978 to 22 January
1979.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
