

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 556/79

of 23 March 1979

amending for the fifth time the list in Regulation (EEC) No 572/73 of egg and poultrymeat products eligible for the advance fixing of export refunds

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2771/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in eggs ⁽¹⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 368/76 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 9 (3) thereof,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2777/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in poultrymeat ⁽³⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 369/76 ⁽⁴⁾, and in particular Article 9 (3) thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 572/73 ⁽⁵⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1318/75 ⁽⁶⁾, provided that export refunds could be fixed in advance, on request, for the products listed in the Annex thereto;

Whereas the present market situation, and in particular export opportunities justify the inclusion of a certain number of products under the system of rules on advance fixing of export refunds;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Poultrymeat and Eggs,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The Annex to Commission Regulation (EEC) No 572/73 is replaced by the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 April 1979.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
